Qualification for Professor in Allied subjects namely Community Medicine, Pathology, Physiology, Surgery & Obs/Gynae

A. ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION

- i) Post Graduate Degree in Homoeopathy with not less than 5 years of teaching exp. As an Associate Professor in the subject concern or not less than 10 years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a recognized homoeopathic medical institution; or
- ii) Post Graduate medical degree in the concerned subject recognized by the National Medical Commission with 5 years of teaching experience as an Associate Professor in the subject concerned or not less than 10 years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a homoeopathic medical institution or in a medical college permitted by the Central Govt. or
- iii) Recognized under graduate degree in Homoeopathy along with post graduate degree in a medical anatomy for anatomy or in medical physiology or biochemistry for physiology or in legal medicine (forensic medicine) for forensic medicine & toxicology or in public health for community medicine from recognized University or medical institution as recognized by the National Medical Commission with 12 years of regular teaching experience in the subject concerned in a homoeopathic medical institution; or

- (C) Recognized post graduate qualification in Homoeopathy in subject concerned with not less than five years of full time research experience in Teaching institution or in Research Council of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory administration or University or National Institutions with at least three publications in indexed or peer reviewed journal and qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the commission or
- (D) Must have not less than five years of experience in regular service after acquiring post graduate degree in subject concerned in the Central Government Health services or State Govt. Health Services, , Ministry of AYUSH or full time five years of experience as medical officer in regular service after acquiring post graduate degree in the concerned subject in recognized Homoeopathy Medical Institute and having qualified National Teachers Eligibility Test conducted by the Commission.
